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About the College

Debraj Roy College (Autonomous), established in 1949. It was the first college in the district and was initially affiliated with Guwahati University before transitioning to Dibrugarh University in 1965.

The college offers UG and P.G. degree in science and humanities, serving around 2700 students. It has been celebrating its Platinum Jubilee Year in 2024-2025. Recognized for academic excellence, it was accredited by NAAC with an "A" Grade (81%), later reaccredited in 2011 (CGPA 3.11, A-Grade), and in 2023 (3rd Cycle, "A" Grade).

The Department of Economics was started in 1958-59. From 1960-61 academic years major classes were started. Since then many teachers have been appointed and some of them are now retired. Among these retired teachers, late P R Neog, Mr. C K Gogoi, Mr. K. Saikia and Mr. B. Saikia, Late Sabera Khanam, and Ms. Loni Phukan contributed highly to the department. The Department of Economics started P.G. courses in 2022 affiliated to Dibrugarh University and from 2024, the department has started its first P.G. Autonomous batch. The department regularly organises seminars, and workshop group discussions and publishes its peer-reviewed journal 'Eco-Centric' and several books. The Department also offers several Diploma Courses including NGO Management, Vermicompost and Retail Management
